Starting a Propane Grill Answers

1. First, make sure that the burner control knobs are _____. (*Answer: "off."*)
2. Next, open the grill lid, and leave it open, before doing anything else. Why is that important? (*Answer: "to ensure that gas vapors aren't trapped in a closed space."*)
3. There are burner control knobs on the grill, and an on-off valve on the propane bottle. Which one do you always open first? (*Answer: "the on-off valve on the propane bottle."*)
4. After you open the on-off valve on the propane bottle, which grill burner valve should you open first? The grill burner valve closest to the automatic lighter, or the one furthest away? (*Answer: "the one closest to the ignition source." If using a match or lighter, keep the flame next to the burner producing the flow of gas.*)
5. Which grill burner valve do you open after the first one is lit? (*Answer: "open the remaining burners in sequence starting with burners closest to the burner that is already lit."*)
